PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Project name: Borgesius Bakkersland Location: Wateringen (NL)

Year: 2018 Size: 8000m²

Borgesius Bakkersland, founded in 1895 in Oude Pekela, the Netherlands, is now a company with 20 modern bakeries. The floor of the Wateringen branch needed to be renovated.

PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

The old, damaged tiling needed to be replaced with a flooring suitable for bakery requirements, thus resistant to high thermal and mechanical loads. The main requirement was to quickly resume production. An independent inspection showed that only the damaged floor and subfloor needed to be removed.

SIKA SOLUTIONS

To carry out the floor renovation within the shortest timeframe, the subfloor was repaired using fast-curing and rapid-setting repair mortars SikaEmaco® T 1100 TIX and SikaEmaco® T 1200 PG, allowing for anchor grooves to be prepared the next day. Sika® Ucrete® DP 10 was installed on the 3rd and 4th day. Thanks to this precise planning, the bakery could resume its activities the following day.

The low VOC emission Sika® Ucrete® systems do not contaminate foodstuffs. They are certified "Indoor Air Comfort Gold" by Eurofins laboratory.
